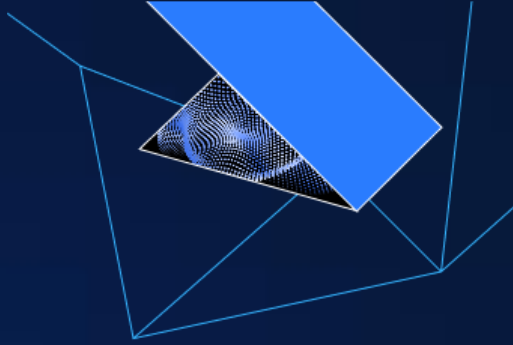
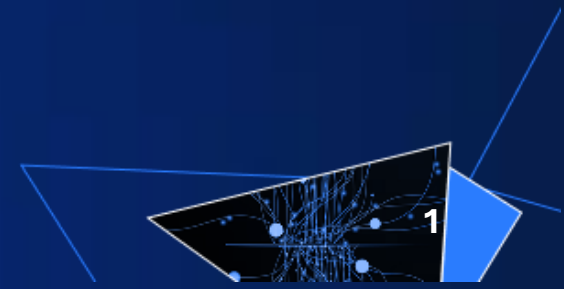


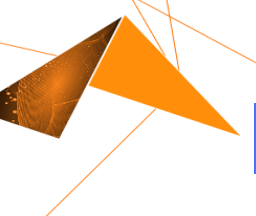

In Fort Portal Tourism City. Security forces, including the army and police, are actively engaging suspected ADF rebels in Canon Apollo North division. The presence of Mayor Joseph Mashuhuko and Muhumuza Richard on the ground suggests a coordinated effort to manage the situation and ensure public safety.

Given the recent history of ADF attacks in the region, particularly in Kamwenge district where civilians were killed, the security response is likely aimed at neutralizing the threat and preventing further incidents. In recent months, the UPDF has been actively hunting down ADF rebels.

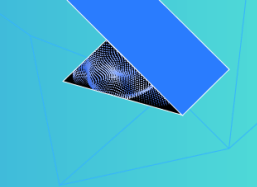
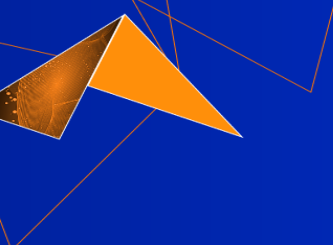


Using Perplexity - Conclusions

95% of the answer is incorrect due to:

- References outside the time period
- References outside the topic
- Lack of local references (References only in one language (that of the question))
- References unrelated to the answer elements

And it's difficult to verify because Perplexity doesn't display the date of its references!!!
